**Responsive Reading - Psalm 27 (NIV)**

**MINISTER:** 1. The Lord is my light and my salvation- whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life- of whom shall I be afraid? 2. When the wicked advance against me to devour me, it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall.
